MAY

New Delivery Time for EDI Files to Give You the Latest Information

XIT LINK users: more accurate information in your EDI files

- ▶ Network Delivery Data files (inbound stock) now to be delivered at 3pm EST prior to onsale

- ▶ As delivery details can change up to the last minute this ensures your files contain the latest in accurate information

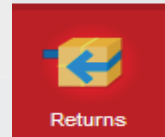


MAY

Numbering of Return Weeks Adjusted in EDI Files

Change to how return weeks are numbered simplifies returns

- ▶ Return weeks now based on Tuesday - Monday: e.g. 5/1/10 - 11/1/10 = week #1
- ▶ Change made in consultation with all major POS vendors
- ▶ Simplifies separation of regular and supplementary returns by POS systems

'Pick to Light' Packing System Introduced to QLD & TAS DC's

Pick to Light. Fewer pick errors. Fewer Bundles

- ▶ Live in QLD and TAS (Via VIC) DC's in May 2010
- ▶ Fewer pick errors reduces shortages

'Pick to Light' Means New Look Delivery Labels in QLD & TAS

New look delivery documents. Same information

- ▶ Details customer, statement references, volumes & values
- ▶ More details to follow

All ACP Book Returns Now Managed by NETonline & XChangeIT

No more paper book forms

- ▶ NETonline & XChangeIT LINK now manage all book returns
- ▶ Recalls notified by email. Supplementary returns via NETonline & XChangeIT
- ▶ More details to follow

The Following SupplyNET Changes Are Now LIVE

Go to www.netonline.com.au and visit the returns page for more details

- ▶ Electronic receiving and auditing LIVE in your DC. All returns must be shipped using barcoded labels and include a copy of the barcoded returns confirmation. Unsure of the process? See NETonline
- ▶ Paper early and late returns not accepted. POS printouts not accepted. Those received are ignored
